Many positions such as STEWARDS and DECKHANDS aboard American Cruise Lines' ships do not require any particular experience or education in this area. American Cruise Lines may provide training to employees or prospective employees.

American Cruise Lines operates coastal and inland waterway cruise ships on the East Coast and the Pacific Northwest generally on 7 day cruises. The crew consists of approximately 16 to 30 crewmembers performing a wide range of tasks. Shipboard employees live onboard the ship while working.

The ships operate through most of the year. During summer months, the ships operate cruises in the New England area and Pacific Northwest. In the spring and fall months, the ships operate in the Mid-Atlantic region, and during the winter they generally cruise in Florida and the Southeast region.

General positions aboard ship include DECKHANDS and STEWARDS and GALLEY STEWARDS. Managerial positions include HOTEL MANAGERS, CHEFS, CRUISE DIRECTORS, MATES, ENGINEERS and CAPTAINS. U.S. Coast Guard licenses are required for CAPTAINS, ENGINEERS and MATES. The minimum educational requirement for all shipboard positions is a high school diploma.

STEWARDS, DECKHANDS AND GALLEY STEWARDS ARE HIRED ONLY AS TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED TWELVE (12) WEEKS (EXCLUDING TIME OFF.) Individuals may re-apply to American Cruise Lines at some future date; however, they will receive no preferential treatment and should not plan on being re-hired.

OVERTIME POLICY

In accordance with applicable Federal Law, shipboard employees who work primarily on board company vessels will not receive overtime from the company, even when they are working on shore. These employees are exempt from the overtime under the "Fair Labor Standards Act," 29 U.S.C. Section 213 (b) (6), see also 29 CFR Section 783.32.
